Production

- Dashboards;

Required investments

Over USD 15 mln.

Payback period

4-5 years

Investment benefits of the project:

- Volume of the plastic automotive components market in the Russian Federation is about USD 1 billion;
- Market of plastic automotive components of the Russian Federation shows a 20-30% annual growth due to the process of localization of the assembly of foreign vehicles;
- Despite steady growth, the Russian market of automotive components is not developed enough. This fact causes demand for automotive components and creates good conditions for export.

Additional information:

- Using polymeric materials allows to decrease the weight of the vehicle up to 15-30% and fuel consumption up to 0.5 liters per 100 km;
- Nearly three quarters of vehicle interior are made from plastic, synthetic materials and faux leather.


